It is highly desirable that the candidates who nominate to go on the Panel are able to demonstrate the following attributes:

- Is a man of good character and has demonstrated, over a period of time, attachment to the Craft and loyalty to the United Grand Lodge of Victoria.
- Possesses a thorough understanding of the state of the Craft in Victoria and an appreciation of the challenges which it faces.
- Possesses an understanding of the vision and the Strategic imperatives for the future of Freemasonry in Victoria and an understanding of what will be required to bring the vision and strategic imperatives to reality.
- Can demonstrate an understanding of the governance structures of the United Grand Lodge of Victoria, the Board of General Purposes and the role of the Grand Master and Deputy Grand Master within those structures.
- Understands the skills and experience required for the position of Grand Master and Deputy Grand Master and his responsibilities.
- Possesses the skills and personal qualities which will enable him to contribute to the panel in its selection process.

Each applicant will need to submit a short biographical summary of maximum 100 words and a photograph.
